## 2022 NABBA Partner information

The 2022 North American Brass Band Association Championships will be held **April 29-30, 2022** in Huntsville, Alabama at the Von Braun Center.

All Partners will be vending in East Hall 2 of the Von Braun Center. This area is strategically located directly between the concert venues and the solo & ensemble venues. This room will allow for instrument play-testing to occur during all contest events without any concern for sound bleeding over to the performance venues. The East Hall loading dock is on the back side of East Hall 1, located around the back of the arena off of Monroe Street. Drop shipping to the Von Braun Center will be available.
